Build an RB/WR foundation, take an advantage TE when the price is right, stay patient at quarterback, and prioritize high-upside bench players over low-ceiling depth.

4. POSITION RANKINGS & TIERS

Tier breaks make positional scarcity easy to see on draft day.

RB	Tier 1	Jaxon Rivers, Andre Bishop, Darius King, Theo Grant	Rounds 1-2	Four anchor backs.
RB	Tier 2	Marcus Hale, Owen Price, Cam Monroe, Eli Warren	Rounds 2-4	Strong starter pool.
RB	Upside	Kendrick Moss, Jaylen Ford, Nico Vega	Rounds 7-11	Bench ceiling targets.

TIER ALERT

The sample player pool has a sharper drop at RB and TE than at WR. When two players grade similarly, scarcity can break the tie.

EARLY-ROUND RULE

A small reach is acceptable only when the player is a genuine priority, the league-value ranking supports it, and waiting until the next pick creates a meaningful risk of losing him.

6. YOUR DRAFT PATH - ROUNDS 6-10

Mid-round planning focuses on contingencies and roster ceiling.

QUARTERBACK CONTINGENCY PLAN

Plan A: Evan Cole around Picks 50-65.
Plan B: Noah Reed around Picks 70-90.
Plan C: keep taking value and select the best remaining starter-level QB later. Losing Plan A should never create a panic pick.

7. TAKE HIM NOW OR WAIT?

This page answers the core Draft Path question: can the player reasonably be expected to reach your next selection?

HOW TO READ THIS TABLE

A low return probability means waiting is dangerous. A high return probability means the customer can often take a stronger value now and revisit the player later. ***All probabilities in this sample are fictional.**

This guidance is prepared in the emailed packet before draft day. There is no live on-the-clock feature in the product.

8. SCHEDULE & TIE-BREAKER ADVANTAGES

Schedule grades are secondary inputs used to separate otherwise similar players.

HOW SCHEDULE SHOULD AFFECT YOUR DRAFT

Use schedule as a tie-breaker, not a reason to pass on a clearly superior player. Role, projected opportunity, league value, and acquisition cost remain more important.

9. LATE-ROUND TARGET BOARD

Bench picks should have a believable path to becoming more valuable after the draft.

WR	Malik Stone	Second-year breakout	TARGET 4-6	Customer favorite with target growth.

WR	Jordan Banks	Deep-threat sophomore	WATCH 8-11	Bench ceiling over floor.

BENCH-BUILDING PHILOSOPHY

Avoid filling the bench with players whose best-case outcome is remaining a bench player. Favor ambiguous backfields, young receivers, contingent-value RBs, and other profiles that can become weekly starters.

10. DRAFT-DAY CHECKLIST & NOTES

A clean print page for the customer to keep beside the draft.

BEFORE THE DRAFT

- Confirm draft slot and scoring
- Review late news
- Circle priority targets
- Review QB contingency
- Keep D/ST and K late

DURING THE DRAFT

- Cross off drafted players
- Check the next-pick gap before reaching
- Watch tier breaks
- Do not chase runs automatically
- Use stacks only as tie-breakers

YOUR FIVE PERSONAL RULES

1. Do not reach more than one round for a non-priority player.
2. Strongly consider Mason Vale at #15 if available.
3. If Evan Cole goes early, move to Noah Reed rather than panicking.
4. Prefer upside RB/WR bench picks over an early defense.
5. Fades become draftable when the discount is large enough.
